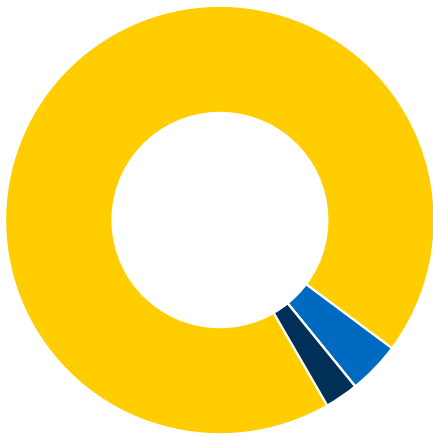

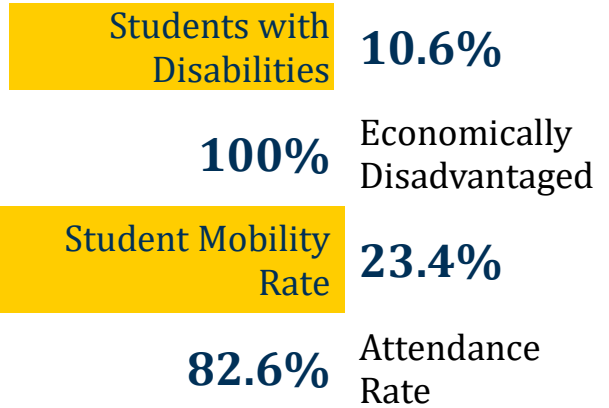

The percentage proficient in English Language Arts increased from 32.9% in 2023-2024 to 41.5% in 2024-2025.

The percentage proficient in Mathematics increased from 29.2% in 23-24 to 32.3% in 2024-25.

Performance Index increased by over six points. Discipline occurrences decreased by over 10% from 2024 to 2025.

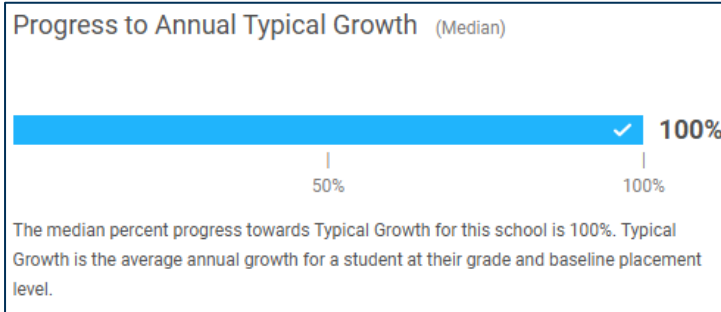
Our Academic Goals

- #3** By FY2027, the overall percentage of students reaching proficiency or above on English Language Arts and Mathematics state tests will increase by 45%.

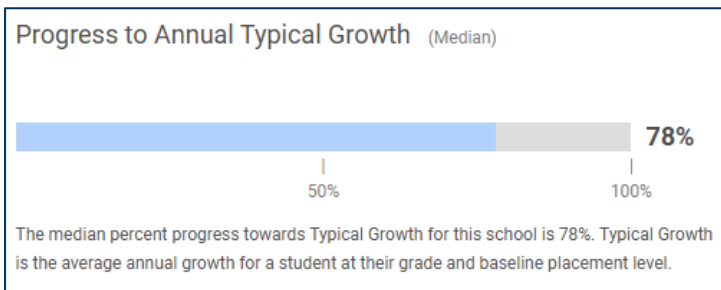

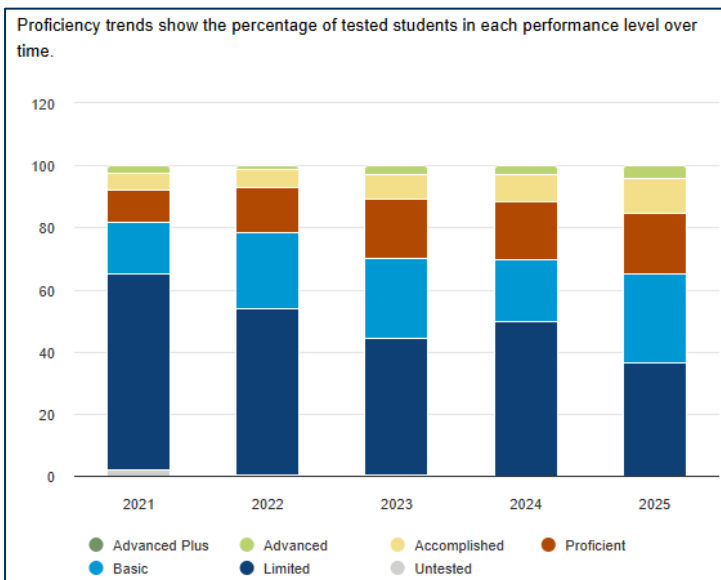
iReady Data Reading
